

**Rules & Regulations of Online Application for**  
**B.Ed. Admission (2023-25)**

1. **Medium of instructions: Bengali/ English**
2. **The B.Ed. programme shall be of a duration of two academic sessions.**
3. **Total number of seats - 50 (Fifty). 05% of the seats will be reserved for Deputed teachers of classes V-XII. Deputed teachers mean the teachers serving in substantive posts.**
4. **If requisite numbers of Deputed candidates are not available, vacant seats will be filled up from the Fresher candidates with due approval from Affiliating University.**
5. **Eligibility:-**
  - Candidates should be Graduates in a school subject from a recognized university.
  - Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree (General) / or in the Master's Degree in School subjects are eligible to apply.
  - Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology or any equivalent degree with Science and/or Mathematics, with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are also eligible for admission. Such candidates are required to enter the marks of B.E/ B. Tech. in the row of Honours Degree. M.E. / M. Tech result (if any) will be entered in the Master's Degree row.
  - Honours Graduates in school subject should enter the Honours marks only in the row of Bachelor's degree (Honours).
  - In case of General Graduates, the total marks obtained in general subjects should be entered in the row of Bachelor's degree (General).

- For candidates with less than 50% marks in the honours degree, the total marks of pass and Honours subjects will be considered. If it becomes 50% or more, that score will be entered in Graduation (General) row.
- For fresh candidates, merit list will be prepared separately for each school subject based on scoring.
- For Deputed Candidates, merit list will be prepared separately for each school subject based on length of service.
- Age of applicants (all) & Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/PWD (Minimum disability 40%) candidates will be as per Govt. Rules.
- Relaxation of 5% in the qualifying marks will be allowed in graduation or post-graduation in case of SC/ST/OBC/PWD ( Minimum disability 40%) candidates. That is, in such cases minimum 45% marks will be required instead of 50% marks.

## **Admission procedure for B.Ed. Course:**

Admission will be on the basis of scores against marks obtained in qualifying examinations and as per norms of University. Maximum Scores against marks for different level of examinations will be as follows:

### **For scoring in HS, the marks obtained in best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies will be considered.**

- Deputed Teachers (as per NCTE norms) from recognized Secondary & Higher Secondary School of West Bengal are eligible to apply.
- Please note very carefully that as per letter F.No. DEB/QMC/2013 dated 23.08.2013, issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC), Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, New Dehil – 110002, a University established or incorporated by or under a State Act shall operate Open and Distance Learning Programme only within the territorial jurisdiction allotted to it under its Act and in no case beyond the territory of the State of its location.
- On the basis of on-line submission of application a merit list will be prepared without verification of the accuracy and authenticity of the data submitted by the applicants. The rank of the merit list may change due to any inaccuracy / insufficiency and lack of authenticity of the data entered.
- Admission will be offered by the College after verification of the accuracy / sufficiency and authenticity of the data entered by the Applicants.
- Applicants shall remain responsible for the inaccuracy / insufficiency and lack of authenticity of the data entered and the candidature may be refused at any stage of admission and even during the continuation of the programme.

### **For Deputed Candidates:**

Applicants deputed by School must submit an attested copy of M.C. resolution **recording the approval of Service in regard to his/her service with the form.**

**Following additional documents are required to be submitted positively on the day of counseling/verification in the institutions:**

1. Release order from the Headmaster / Headmistress.
2. Attested copy of M.C. resolution with regards to his/her deputation, countersigned by D. I. of Schools (Secondary).
3. Certificate from Competent Authority whether the candidate teaches in Class V or above.
4. Three copies of passport size photographs of the applicant.
5. A certificate with the following information is to be submitted from the Secretary or Headmaster/Headmistress (where he/she is serving) and counter signed by the D.I. of Schools of the District concerned:
  - ✓ Certified that the School is in receipt of aid on full/ deficit/ lump sum grant basis or that school in unaided or salary deficit scheme one.
  - ✓ Certified that she/he is duly approved teacher.
  - ✓ Certified that she/he is duly approved teacher.
  - ✓ **Certified that she/he is being deputed by the school for undergoing two year B.Ed. Courses (2023-25)**

Candidates pursuing any other course in any other University during 2023-2024 academic session are not eligible for admission to the B. Ed. programme for the session 2023-25.

**Procedure of application :**

- a) Download the information and read it very carefully to ensure your eligibility for admission to B. Ed. course for the session 2023-25.
- b) Download the online application form and fill up all the column of the form , attach photograph ( Java Software or scanned image ), & scanned signature properly. Uploaded documents should be clear enough for online verification purpose otherwise the Application will be rejected. Retain a print out copy of the complete filled up application form for further verification ( Print of the filled in form, Aadhar card certificate , Original copies of Marks sheets & Certificates, filled up and signed affidavit on anti ragging as per UGC Regulations 2009, along with one copy of Xerox of all documents must be submitted for further verification at the college on the scheduled date).

6. **Schedule: (Tentative)**

- c. Online correction (Admission portal will remain open for correction, if any) of Application form – 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2023
- d. Declaration of provisional Merit List of all applicants on the college website on Dt: 18.09.2023.
- e. Publication of 1<sup>st</sup> Merit list for admission on Dt: 19/09/2023
- f. Contact college authority for any technical problem with regards to inclusion in merit panel through application on Dt: 20/09/2023 before 12.30 PM through college mail.
- g. Date of 1<sup>st</sup> counseling/verification of documents & Admission- 10.30 AM on 21<sup>st</sup> September, 2023.
- h. In case of any vacancy, 2<sup>nd</sup> counseling/verification of documents & admission will be held on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2023 at 10.30 AM.
- i. In case of any further vacancy , 3<sup>rd</sup> counseling/verification of documents & admission will be held on 27<sup>th</sup> September , 2023 at 10.30 PM.
- j. In case of any anomaly found during verification or afterwards, admission will be cancelled and fees will not be refunded.
- k. Commencement of the new session on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.
