Theme: Tribal Empowerment

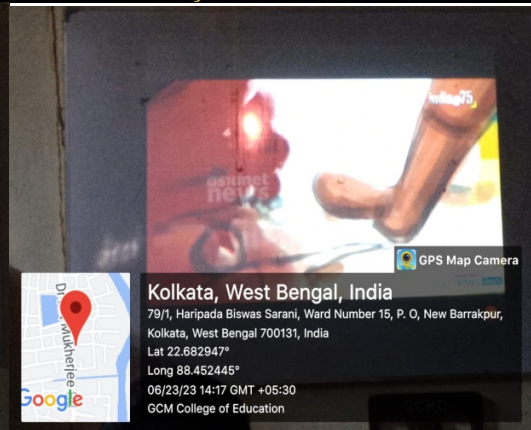
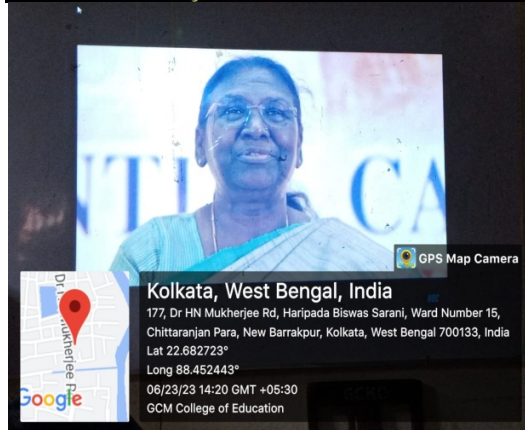
Activity - Film screening on Tribal empowerment.

A workshop was conducted on Best out of Waste in the College. Students prepared various items from waste and discarded materials such as pots from plastic bottles and puppets from newspapers.

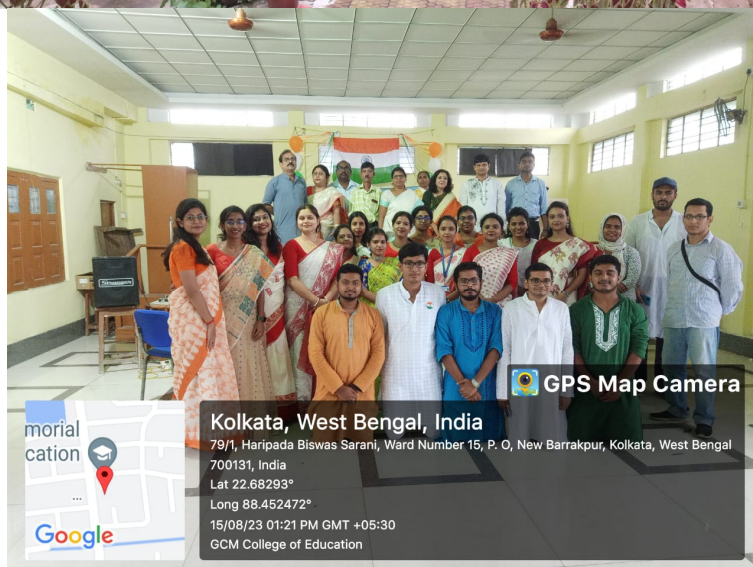
**Theme: Inclusive Development
